

German Shorthaired Pointer

Height Dogs 23” to 25”

Bitches 21" to 23"

General Appearance - Versatile hunter, aristocratic, well balanced indicating power, endurance, agility and a look of intelligence and animation. Medium size like a proper hunter "with a short back, but standing over plenty of ground".

Head - Clean cut with a reasonably broad skull with only a stop effect. Muzzle and skull are equal in length. **Nose** – Brown on liver and black on black dogs. The larger the nostrils, the better. **Lips** - Full and deep with no flews. **Bite** - Scissor. **Eyes** - Medium, almond shaped and dark brown. **Ears** - Broad, set fairly high, they lie flat above eye level, carried close to head.

Body - Square, or slightly off square, with moderate bone and shown in good hard condition. He should be well-angulated and well-muscled with a short back. **Tail** - Set high and firm, must be docked and should never be carried curved over the back or bent toward the head. He has compact, close-knit feet that are round to spoon-shape.

Coat - Short and thick.

Color - Liver or any combination of liver and white or solid black or any combination of black and white.

Gait - Smooth and lithe with good reach and drive. Tendency to single track as speed increases.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- China or wall eyes
- Flesh colored nose
- Extreme overshot or undershot
- Any color combination of colors other than liver or black as described in the Standard.
- A dog with any area of red, orange, limon, or tan or a dog solid white.
