## Two varieties

13" - for hounds not exceeding 13 inches

15" - for hounds over 13" but not exceeding 15 inches in height.

**General Appearance -** A miniature Foxhound (English), big for his inches, built to last in the chase.

**Head -Skull -** Broad and fairly long with a medium length of muzzle. **Ears -** Fairly long and broad, set moderately low and rounded at the tip with almost no erectile power. **Eyes -** Brown or hazel, large, set well apart with soft hound like expression. **Neck -** Medium length.

**Body** - Compact, moderately angulated and sturdily built with a short back, and broad slightly arched loin, well sprung ribs, and plenty of bone. **Tail** - Short for his size with brush, and set moderately high and carried gaily.

**Coat** - Close, hard, of medium length. **Color** - Any true hound color.

**Note -** Beagles entered in the 13" variety which measure over shall be excused as "ineligible for class."

## DISQUALIFICATIONS:

- Any hound measuring more than 15 inches shall be disqualified.
