

Danish-Swedish Farmdog

Examine on table.

Height - Dogs 13 ½” – 14 ½”, plus or minus 1”

Bitches 12 ½” - 14”, plus or minus ½”.

General Appearance – Small, compact, lively, smooth coated, and slightly rectangular. Not refined or elegant. Clear differentiation between genders is important.

Head – Triangular and a bit small in proportion to the body. **Eyes** – Medium sized, slightly rounded. Dark in dogs with black patches, slightly lighter in dogs with yellow patches. **Ears** – Medium, rose or button. **Skull** – Rather broad with slightly rounded top. **Stop** – Well defined. **Teeth** – Scissors, level acceptable.

Body – Compact with good substance with slight tuck-up. The proportion between the depth of the chest and height at withers is about 1:2. **Topline** – Strong back, slightly arched short, broad loin, slightly rounded croup. **Tail** – Not set too high either naturally long or bobtailed, carried straight with slight curve.

Forequarters – Moderate angulation. Feet – Small, oval and moderately tightly-knit. Legs set wide because of the wide chest.

Hindquarters - Moderate angulation, balanced.

Coat – Short, hard, and smooth.

Color – White dominating. Patches of different color, sizes, and combination are permissible, (black, brown, agouti, yellow, and all shades of tan and fawn).

Gait – Parallel and free.

Temperament – Alert, friendly, attentive, and lively.
